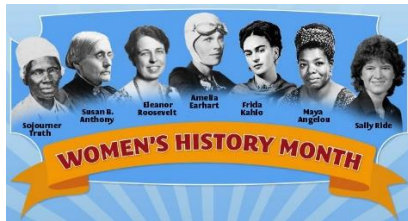

Women's History Month: March 2021

National Women's History Month traces its roots to March 8, 1857, when women from various New York City factories staged a protest over poor working conditions. The first Women's Day celebration in the United States was in 1909, also in New York City. More than seven decades later, Congress in 1981 established National Women's History Week to be commemorated annually the second week of March. In 1987, Congress expanded the week to a month, and every year since has passed a resolution (and the

president has issued a proclamation) designating March Women's History Month.

As we celebrate Women's History Month 2021, we reflect upon advances women have made over the last decade. Women have increased their earnings and education and fields of occupation.

Woman of the WEEK: Oprah Winfrey



Oprah Winfrey is a talk show host, media executive, actress and billionaire philanthropist. She's best known for being the host of her own, wildly popular program, *The Oprah Winfrey Show*, which aired for 25 seasons, from 1986 to 2011. In 2011, Winfrey launched her own TV network, the Oprah Winfrey Network(OWN).


Born in the rural town of Kosciusko, Mississippi, Winfrey moved to Baltimore in 1976, where she hosted *People Are Talking*. Afterward, she was recruited by a Chicago TV station to host her own morning show.

In 1971, Winfrey entered Tennessee State University. She began working in radio and television broadcasting in Nashville.
